

Purchase a TechNet subscription

- If you haven't already done so, purchase a subscription from the Treasurer.
- You should receive an e-mail within a week of your subscription purchase.

Sign up for a Microsoft Live account


- Start at <http://home.live.com/>
- Use Internet Explorer when accessing Microsoft sites. Other browsers will work, but IE just works better.



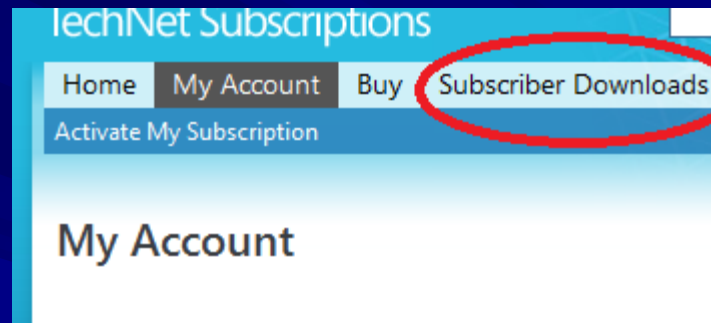

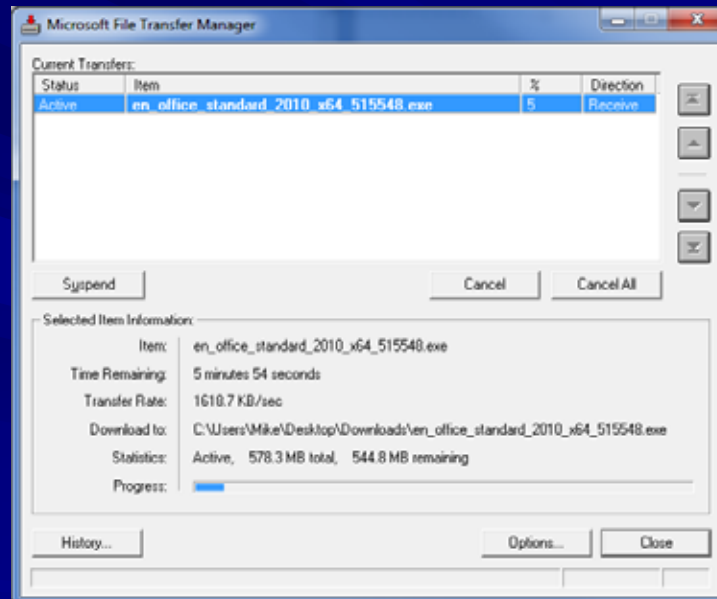
Download software

- When you choose the software, you should be prompted to begin the download. Microsoft File Transfer Manager should start



Download software (cont.)

- Choose the location that you want to download the file and select Transfer.



- When the transfer is complete, access the download.

Generate Key

- While downloading the software, this is a good opportunity to generate the product key for your product.
- Select **Get** under the Product key to generate the product key.

- This key is what is necessary to activate the software that you have downloaded. Keep it in a text file. Copy/paste the key in the product during installation.

Install Software

- Now that you have the software, go forth and install it!
- Some software is in ISO format. You will need to create a CD-ROM/DVD from this.
- Other software is in an executable and you can install it from any source.
